

WE DRILL TOGETHER CONTEST SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

Use this guide when preparing photos or videos for We Drill America contest submissions. This document should be used only in the context of this contest. Refer to your machine's operator's manual for safety messages and further instructions.

Wearing hard hat

Wear hearing protection

Not wearing jewelry, such as rings, wristwatches, necklaces or bracelets

Wearing safety glasses

Wearing high visibility clothing if working near traffic

Rod loader arm barriers are out and side rod box guard is also deployed

Wearing electrically insulated boots

Stakedowns are completely inserted into the ground

High visibility green cones (may be orange on some machines) are placed at each corner of the drill, about 6 ft (2 m) away from the drill, with decals pointing out

Voltage stake must be fully inserted at least 6 ft (2 m) from the machine

Make sure all safety signs and control decals are present on machine

OTHER SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

- Foreign items cannot be seen or are not resting on equipment (e.g. shovels, rolls of tape, etc.)
- Machine does not have non-approved alteration or modification
- Drill not operating near overhead power line
- If a locator is pictured, they must be visibly carrying the Remote Lockout remote
- Only trained operators shown on the drill or jobsite
